MIAMI PORT TUNNEL “Q & A” POSTED

MIAMI, FL. – Questions from potential bidders on the Port of Miami Tunnel Project and answers from the Florida Department of Transportation are now posted at www.portofmiamitunnel.com. Also posted is RFQ Addendum 3 which includes technical adjustments to *experience requirements* as well as an April 3, 2006, extension of the deadline for interested parties to submit questions to Florida’s transportation agency. The deadline for submitting *Statements of Qualifications* remains April 12, 2006.

The Tunnel Project will help maintain the competitiveness of the Port of Miami, Miami-Dade County’s second-leading economic generator, by improving access for cargo and passenger vehicles and reducing congestion along downtown Miami streets. Spearheaded by the Florida Department of Transportation, the project will be developed as a private/public partnership with a concessionaire to be selected by December, 2006.
